OpenStreet provides platforms for micromobility sharing services such as Hello Cycling, an electricassisted bicycle sharing service, with a view toward resolving urban traffic issues and accelerating regional revitalization.

Featuring a user-friendly app, an Internet-of-Things (IoT)¹ lock that may be attached to any bicycle, and other features, the platform allows operators considering the launch of a shared mobility service to start their business quickly at low cost. Thus, OpenStreet operates services across the country. It also operates the Hello Mobility shared mobility service for scooters and ultra-small electric vehicles and the BLUU Smart Parking service for shared parking spaces. It offers many different means of transport for the establishment of Mobility-as-a-Service (MaaS)² networks.

Through this capital and business alliance, ITOCHU ENEX and OpenStreet will explore potential collaborations between OpenStreet's environmentally-excellent micromobility sharing services and ITOCH ENEX's existing businesses.
