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1. Overview of Operating Results and Others

(1) Quarterly Overview of Operating Results

1) Results of operations

During the three months ended June 30, 2025, the Japanese economy experienced a downward trend in crude oil prices amid growing concerns over a global economic slowdown due to uncertainty over trade policies and tariff trends by major countries. In addition, continued geopolitical risks worldwide and significant fluctuations in the foreign exchange market have contributed to persistent uncertainty regarding the overall economic outlook.

The operating results for the three months ended June 30, 2025 are as follows.

Revenue was \(\frac{4}{2}03,200\) million (down 3.7\% year on year).

Profit from operating activities was ¥5,967 million (up 10.2% year on year). This was mainly due to increased sales volumes of electricity in the Power & Utility Division and LP gas in the Home-Life Division, though the Car-Life Division experienced a reactionary effect from the strong sales of used cars in the same period of the previous fiscal year. Net profit attributable to Itochu Enex's shareholders was ¥3,653 million (down 0.9% year on year), remaining nearly flat year on year. This was mainly due to decreased share of profit of investments accounted for by the equity method associated with inventory valuation of investments accounted for by the equity method in the Home-Life Division.

Car-Life Stations (CS)^(*1) business: The number of CS was 1,526, a decrease of 20 compared with the end of the previous fiscal year. Sales volumes of petroleum products were slightly lower year on year.

Automotive business: Our car dealer business subsidiary OSAKA CAR LIFE GROUP CO., LTD. saw a year-on-year decline in sales volumes of both new and used cars.

The operating results for the three months ended June 30, 2025 are as follows.

Revenue was ¥142,586 million (down 1.1% year on year).

Profit from operating activities was \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1,412}\) million (down 20.5% year on year). Net profit attributable to Itochu Enex's shareholders was \(\frac{\pmathbf{7}}{14}\) million (down 11.3% year on year). This was mainly due to lower new and used car sales volumes, as well as a decrease in gross profit per vehicle resulting from a decline in used car market prices in the car dealer business, despite an increase in profit resulting from an improvement in profit margins in the petroleum sales business.

Asphalt sales business: Sales volumes increased year on year due mainly to the acquisition of new commercial rights.

Marine fuel sales business: Sales volumes decreased year on year due to a partial reduction in transactions for ocean-going vessels.

The operating results for the three months ended June 30, 2025 are as follows.

Revenue was ¥26,733 million (down 19.6% year on year). This was mainly due to decreases in selling prices resulting from lower crude oil prices and sales volumes associated with a partial reduction in transactions for ocean-going vessels.

Profit from operating activities was \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{407}\) million (up 1.8% year on year). Net profit attributable to Itochu Enex's shareholders was \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1086}\) million, nearly flat year on year. This was mainly due to robust supply and demand operations, despite a decrease in revenue caused by inventories in the asphalt business being affected by the market downturn.

Electricity power retail business: Although sales volume in low-voltage sales slightly decreased year on year, total sales volume increased year on year^(*2) due to the steady progress in the acquisition of new contracts in high-voltage sales. The number of customers for electricity retail for the entire Group was approximately 311,000, mostly unchanged from the end of the previous fiscal year.

Heat supply business^(*3): Heat sales volume increased year on year due to increased use of air conditioning.

The operating results for the three months ended June 30, 2025 are as follows.

Revenue was \\$16,576 million (down 0.9% year on year).

Profit from operating activities was \(\frac{4}{2}\),585 million (up 28.9% year on year). Net profit attributable to Itochu Enex's shareholders was \(\frac{4}{1}\),422 million (up 25.3% year on year). This was mainly due to an increase in electricity sales volume and stable electricity market conditions.

LP gas business: The number of customers under direct LP gas supply contracts increased by approximately 1,000 from the end of the previous fiscal year to approximately 576,000. Sales volume of LP gas increased year on year.

The operating results for the three months ended June 30, 2025 are as follows.

Revenue was \\$17,305 million (up 2.6\% year on year).

Profit from operating activities was \(\frac{4}{2}404\) million (up 267.3% year on year). This was mainly due to an increase in sales volume of LP gas, improved margins, and cost reductions resulting from more efficient operating activities. Net profit attributable to Itochu Enex's shareholders was \(\frac{4}{3}73\) million (down 39.4% year on year). This was mainly due to a year-on-year decrease in share of profit (loss) of investments accounted for by the equity method due to the impact on inventories resulting from the decline in LP gas import prices at investments accounted for by the equity method.

Total assets amounted to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}12,676}\) million as of June 30, 2025, a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}29,474}\) million from March 31, 2025. This was mainly due to a decrease in trade receivables of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}23,121}{23,121}\) million due to the state of the market and seasonal items. Total liabilities amounted to \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}12,691}{212,691}\) million, a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}6,712}{262}\) million from March 31, 2025. This was mainly due to a decrease in trade payables of \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}18,964}{212,694}\) million, a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}2,762}{22,762}\) million from March 31, 2025, due to factors including an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}3,653}{23,653}\) million from net profit attributable to Itochu Enex's shareholders and a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}6,523}{26,523}\) million by payment of cash dividends.

Cash flows

The Group maintained an operating structure capable of aggressively promoting investment to expand peripheral businesses and develop new business areas, using the cash flow generated from its core businesses.

With respect to financing capacity for the time being, we have sufficiently secured account overdraft facilities and commercial paper issuance facilities, in addition to maintaining ample cash and cash equivalents. Moreover, we have maintained healthy levels of debt thus far, which is currently reflected by our net debt-equity ratio (net DER) of negative 0.11 times.

The Group has always made investments with an awareness of capital efficiency based on our investment strategy.

Investing activities provided net cash of \$5,888 million. This was mainly due to payments for purchase of property, plant and equipment and investment property of \$3,635 million, and recovery of deposits paid of \$10,000 million. Net cash from investing activities increased by \$10,725 million year on year. In addition, substantive investing cash flow increased by \$10,725 million year on year.

Cash flows from financing activities

The Group aims to streamline Group-wide financing activities to enhance our corporate value, and is strengthening financial management through the Group Financial System^(*6).

Financial activities used net cash of \$9,194 million. This was mainly due to repayments of lease liabilities of \$2,658 million, cash dividends paid to Itochu Enex's shareholders of \$3,841 million, and cash dividends paid to non-controlling interests of \$2,682 million. Net cash from financing activities decreased by \$3,064 million year on year.
